Curtis L. Golkow presented "Business Divorce: An M&A Deal Between Existing Owners" at the Wednesday, January 21st meeting of the Mergers & Acquisitions Committee of the Business Law Section of the Philadelphia Bar Association. The event took place at the offices of Kleinbard Bell & Brecker LLP, One Liberty Place, in Philadelphia.

Curtis discussed and analyzed complex issues -- both legal and practical -- involved in assessing the rights and potential claims of business owners going through a business divorce and provided insight into formulating the strategy for handling a business divorce matter. Because the ultimate resolution of the business divorce typically involves the buy-out of one or more business owners, he explained how the particular terms and structure for a business divorce buy-out tend to differ from those of a customary M&A transaction.
